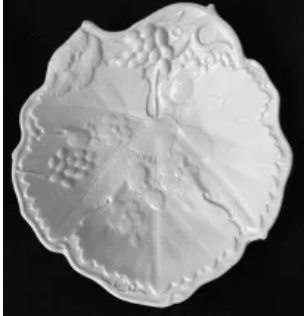
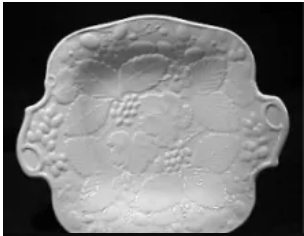
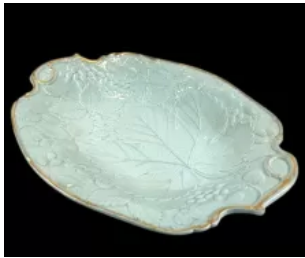
Notes

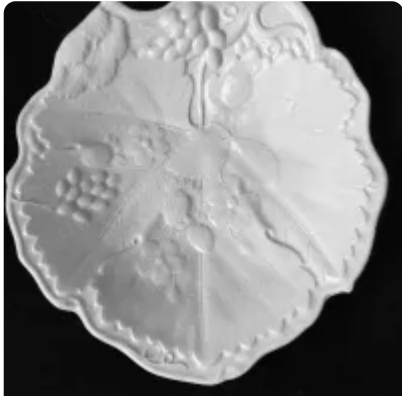

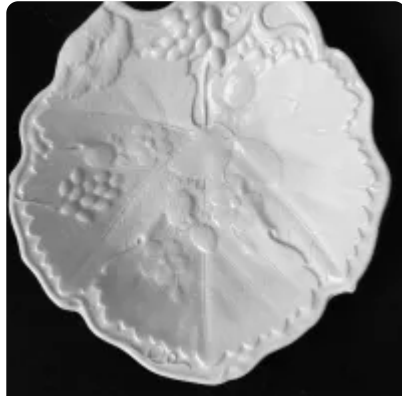
